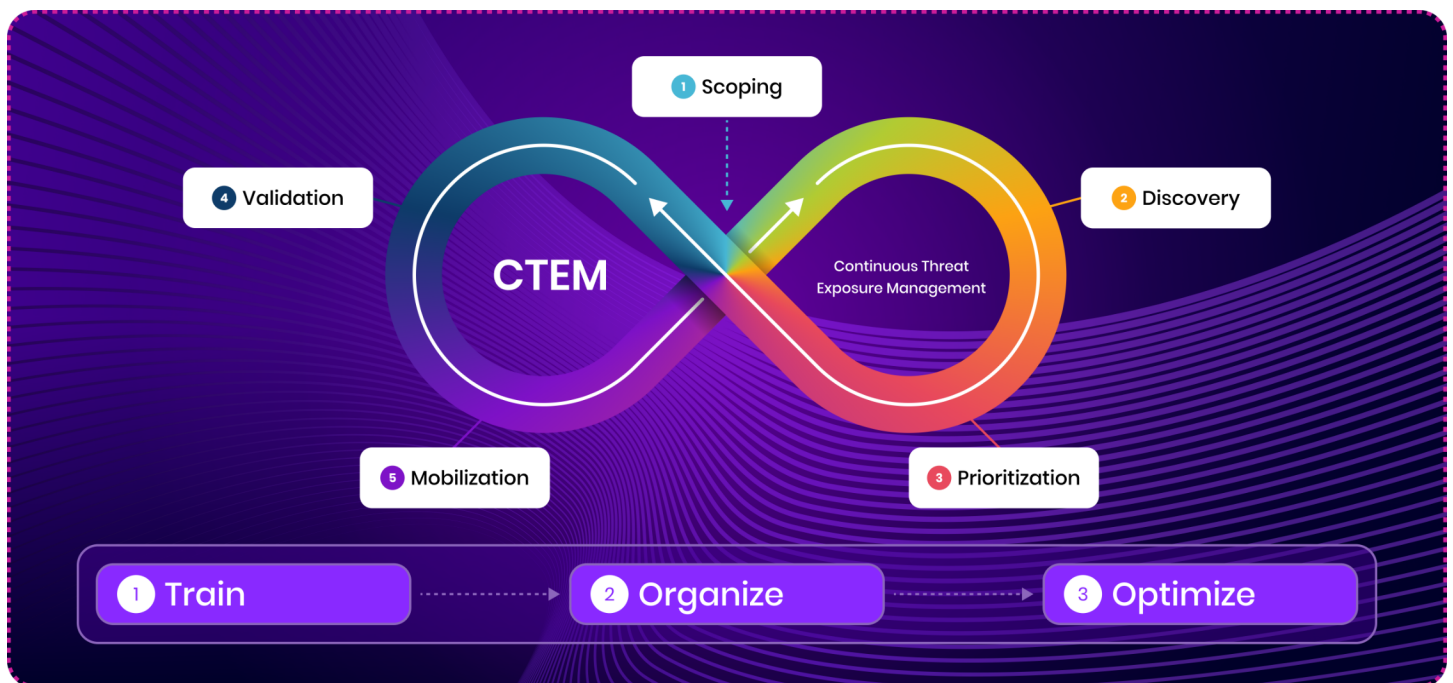


Continuous Threat Exposure Management Implementation

A brief introduction to INFORM will help customers to start thinking about threat-informed defense maturity and how it supports their program.

Key topics include:

- MITRE ATT&CK overview and resources (optional, based on customer need)
- Applying INFORM to measure and mature your threat-informed defense
- Implementing CTEM in the AttackIQ platform

Target participants include team leads, managers, and decision-makers who shape and drive their security practices. This workshop prepares the organization to establish a program designed to evolve through practice.
